## Village Plan / Neighbourhood Plan

Why have a Village Plan or Neighbourhood Plan?

Village Plans and Neighbourhood Plans are a means of collating and documenting the views and wishes of residents and communicating those views to local councils and other authorities. The aim being to influence their decision making particularly in relation to development and protecting what is important to the community. It may also assist in attracting funding for certain suggestions put forward.

The existing Village Plan was produced 8 years ago and the Baylham Parish Meeting (Steering Group) feels that it would be worthwhile to revise it for two main reasons.

Firstly, as we are seeking to form a Parish Council, it will provide the new Council with an accurate and up to date picture of the views of residents to guide it in its activities.

Secondly, experience gained since the Village Plan was written has shown that the Plan is weak in its influence and impact concerning planning and development matters.

Without going into a lot of procedural detail, the main difference between a Neighbourhood Plan and a Village Plan is that in deciding planning applications the District Council has to give much more weight to a Neighbourhood Plan and it can truly influence the decision making process. A Village Plan is no longer a current form of document. The Council is only expected to note views in a Village Plan but is rarely influenced by it.

The preference, therefore, is to produce a Neighbourhood Plan rather than a revised Village Plan as it will give the village a stronger voice. The procedure is more involved but the potential benefit greater.

As the Plan has to represent the village as a whole, we need to capture your thoughts, likes, dislikes, needs, hopes and views generally - and those of anyone living with you - about any issue relating to life in the village. Hence the reason for this survey.

Having received the completed forms, we will collate the answers and present the findings to villagers. To gauge the level of support for each of the suggestions everyone will be given the opportunity to vote for or against the ideas. This in turn will influence the contents of the plan. Some issues may be too complex for a simple 'for' or 'against' answer. For such matters we will arrange further consultation to enable a balanced community view to be identified. A draft plan will then be presented to the village for comments, and amendment if necessary, before a vote on a final draft is arranged.

Please help us help you – by taking a few moments to answer the questions.
